

Script for Video Clip – QuickSearch: Article Search

Use QuickSearch to search for items at all three Reynolds campus libraries including books, articles and videos.

To access QuickSearch, type your search terms in the search box on the library's home page.

We are going to search for ZOMBIES.

When the search results screen appears, you'll want to limit your results to type of resource, depending on what you are looking for.

Today I'm looking for an article, so I will choose **articles** from the Limit my Results on the left.

These articles come from the library's databases. Databases are digital collections of high-quality articles purchased by the library for students to use for their papers and projects.

Did your instructor tell you needed peer reviewed journal articles? Click [HERE](#) to limit your results to peer-reviewed articles only.

Need something recent? Choose a date range here.

I like this one, "Our zombies, ourselves: why we can't get the undead off our brains" by James Parker. Click on it to access the article.

Working off campus or after hours? Students can access these articles on or off campus, 24/7. Just use your My Reynolds login.

This article comes from the Literature Resource Center, one of the library's licensed databases.

Click on the title to read the article.

Scroll down to read the article on the screen.

That is the example showing the Literature Resource Center. Other databases available in QuickSearch include MasterFile Premier and Academic Search Complete.

And that is how to search, find and use an article with QuickSearch.
