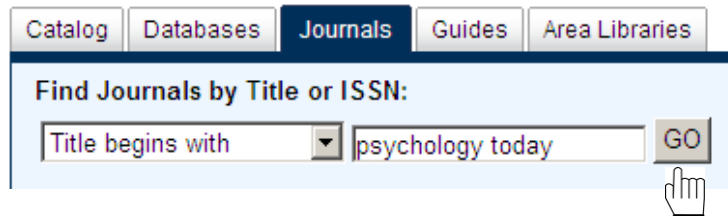

**Using the Journal Locator Tool**

Use the Journal Locator tool to find out where you can get the full-text of the following article:

Revolution for Two by Pamela Weintraub from the May/June 2011 issue of *Psychology Today*.

1. From the library's home page at <http://library.reynolds.edu>, click on the **Journals** tab above the search box.
2. When the *Find Journals by Title or ISSN* box appears, type **psychology today** in the *Title begins with* search window. Press the <Enter> key or click on the **GO** button to execute the search.



3. When the results screen appears, review the information.
4. **How many years back** does the Downtown & Parham Campus Libraries hold for the **print copy** of *Psychology Today*?

7. When the *Academic Search Complete Publication Details* screen appears for *Psychology Today*, click on the **+2011** link. When the individual issue links for 2011 appear, click on the **May/June 2011** issue.


